## A RESOLUTION

Requesting the Secretary of the United States Department of Agriculture, the Administrator of the Farmers Home Administration in Washington, D.C., and the State Director of the Farmers Home Administration in the state of Hawaii to expand the programs currently administered in the Federated States of Micronesia by the Farmers Home Administration and to extend to the people of the Federated States of Micronesia the benefits of those other programs and services not currently made available to the people of the Federated States of Micronesia by the Farmers Home Administration.

- WHEREAS, the United States Department of Agriculture, the Farmers
- 2 Home Administration, and the State Director of the Farmers Home Adminis-
- 3 tration in the state of Hawaii are fully aware of the need and demand in
- 4 the Federated States of Micronesia for the programs and services provided
- 5 by the Farmers Home Administration; and
- 6 WHEREAS, that awareness is clearly manifested in the extension of
- 7 two of the programs and services provided by the Farmers Home Adminis-
- 8 tration to the Federated States of Micronesia and by the establishment
- 9 of field offices in three of the States of the Federated States of Micro-
- 10 nesia; and
- 11 WHEREAS, many of the people of the Federated States of Micronesia
- 12 are grateful for being able to receive the benefits of the two programs
- 13 currently made available to them; and
- 14 WHEREAS, without belittling the importance of the two programs
- 15 currently available, the recipients of the Farmers Home Administration
- 16 loans are of the opinion that the \$2,500 maximum ceiling for each loan
- 17 is far too low and feel that the same loan program could be more
- 18 meaningful if the ceiling were increased to at least \$7,000, the amount
- 19 extended to recipients of the same loan program in other jurisdictions;
- 20 and
- 21 WHEREAS, the people of the Federated States of Micronesia are
- 22 painfully aware of the fact that the Farmers Home Administration adminis-
- 23 ters 32 programs, and of these 32 programs only 2 are extended to the
- 24 Federated States of Micronesia; and
- 25 WHEREAS, the people of the Federated States of Micronesia do

1 recognize the eminent role these Farmers Home Administration programs

- 2 play in the economic development of other jurisdictions; and
- 3 WHEREAS, these same people are earnestly desirous of receiving the
- 4 benefits of any and all of the programs that are sponsored and administered
- 5 by the Farmers Home Administration in order to help foster the needed
- 6 economic development growth in the Federated States of Micronesia; now,
- 7 therefore,
- 8 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of
- 9 Micronesia, Second Special Session, 1984, that the Secretary of the
- 10 United States Department of Agriculture, the Administrator of the Farmers
- 11 Home Administration in Washington, D.C., and the State Director of the
- 12 Farmers Home Administration in the state of Hawaii be requested, and the
- 13 same are hereby respectfully requested, to expand the programs currently
- 14 administered in the Federated States of Micronesia and to extend to the
- 15 people of the Federated States of Micronesia the benefits of those
- 16 programs and services not currently being made available to the people of
- 17 the Federated States of Micronesia by the Farmers Home Administration;
- 18 and
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be
- 20 transmitted to the Honorable John R. Block, Secretary of the United States
- 21 Department of Agriculture; Charles W. Shuman, Administrator of the Farmers
- 22 Home Administration; Robert W.F. Choy, Director of the Farmers Home
- 23 Administration for the state of Hawaii; Leonard Aquiqui, Farmers Home
- 24 Administration District Director for the Pacific Region Territories;
