A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend section 403 of title 40 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, reducing the size of the Board of Regents of the College of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 403 of title 40 of the Code of the Federated
2 States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 403. Board of Regents. There shall be a Board of
4 Regents of the College of Micronesia which shall consist of
5 the following members who shall serve for the following terms:

6 (1) *one member from each administrative district of the*
7 *Trust Territory appointed by the District Administrator, with*
8 *the advice and consent of the District Legislature, to serve*
9 *a term of four years, provided, that the District Administrator*
10 *shall submit his nomination to the district legislature for the*
11 *first member appointed pursuant to this subsection on or before*
12 *November 10, 1977; provided further, that at the first Board*
13 *meeting the members appointed pursuant to this subsection shall*
14 *by drawing lots designate three members to serve an initial term*
15 *of two years;*

16 (1) one member each from the Republic of Belau, the
17 Federated States of Micronesia, and the Marshall Islands,
18 appointed by the Chief Executive of that political entity, with
19 the advice and consent of the local legislative body, to serve
20 a term of 3 years; provided that at the first Board meeting the
21 members appointed pursuant to this subsection shall, by drawing
22 lots, determine a member to serve an initial term of 1 year, a
23 member to serve an initial term of 2 years, and a member to serve
24 an initial term of 3 years;

25 (2) *two one members* appointed by the High Commissioner



1 with the advice and consent of the Congress of Micronesia to
 2 serve a terms of four 2 years, one of whom who is noted in the
 3 Trust Territory for his or her accomplishments in the field of
 4 economic development and who is not a full time employee of the
 5 executive or judicial branch of the Trust Territory Government
 6 at district level, any of the three nations mentioned in section
 7 1 or political subdivisions thereof, and or the other of whom is
 8 a nonresident of the Trust Territory but who resides within the
 9 Pacific area who is well recognized in the field of education for
 10 his or her work with post-secondary institutions of learning;
 11 provided, that the High Commissioner shall submit his nominations
 12 to the Congress of Micronesia for the first members appointed
 13 pursuant to this subsection on or before November 10, 1977,
 14 provided further, that the High Commissioner shall designate one
 15 of the first two members appointed pursuant to this subsection to
 16 serve an initial term of two years, and

17 (3) The Chairman of the Trust Territory Board of Education,
 18 or its successor.

19 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the President
 20 of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such
 21 approval.
