A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$127,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1984, for the purpose of funding various public projects in the Hall, Namonwito, and Western Islands in Truk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$127,000, or so much thereof as may be
2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated
3 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1984,
4 for the purpose of funding various public projects in the Hall,
5 Namonwito, and Western Islands in Truk State. The sum appropriated
6 shall be apportioned as follows:

- 7 (1) Murilo dock construction \$10,000
- 8 (2) Ruo basketball court 5,000
- 9 (3) Fananu ice plant 10,000
- 10 (4) Nomwin public projects 10,000
- 11 (5) Pesarach public projects 5,000
- 12 (6) Ono survey projects 10,000
- 13 (7) Onary public projects 5,000
- 14 (8) Magur public projects 5,000
- 15 (9) Ulul meeting hall improvement 5,000
- 16 (10) Weito boat 22,000
- 17 (11) Pulap public project 10,000
- 18 (12) Tamatam sea wall 10,000
- 19 (13) Puluwat municipal office construction 10,000
- 20 (14) Pulusuk public projects 10,000.

21 Section 2. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
22 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable
23 law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
24 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds,
25 or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose

1 specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
2 of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottee to obligate
3 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1984.

4 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
5 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
6 law without such approval.
