A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$382,500 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1985, for the purpose of funding public projects in the State of Yap, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$382,500, or so much thereof as may be
2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
4 1985, for the purpose of funding public projects in the State of Yap.

5 The funds appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:

- 6 (1) Wottegai taro patch reclamation \$ 7,000
- 7 (2) Yap State transportation system 50,000
- 8 (3) Woleai Junior High School 39,000
- 9 (4) Kanifay Elementary School 16,000
- 10 (5) Gilman Elementary School 37,000
- 11 (6) Gagil Elementary School 20,500
- 12 (7) Colonia Community Center 20,000
- 13 (8) Yap proper power distribution 20,000
- 14 (9) Yap proper road development 20,000
- 15 (10) Completion of dispensaries on Faraulep,
16 Lamotrek, and Ifalik atolls 15,000
- 17 (11) Completion of Elato Elementary School 10,000
- 18 (12) Outer islands agriculture projects 15,000
- 19 (13) Eauripik Elementary School 40,000
- 20 (14) Lamotrek Elementary School 38,000
- 21 (15) Renovation of Rull Municipal Office 35,000


22 Section 2. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
23 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable
24 law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
25 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds,



1 or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose
 2 specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
 3 of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottee to obligate
 4 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1985.
 5 The allottee may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from the funds
 6 appropriated to each of the subsections in section 1.

7 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President
 8 of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without
 9 such approval.
