A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 2-35, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 2-42 and 3-5, which appropriated the sum of \$637,600 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1982, for the purpose of funding public projects in the State of Ponape, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 2-35, as amended by Public
2 Laws Nos. 2-42 and 3-5, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. Appropriation. The sum of \$637,600, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
5 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
6 fiscal year ending September 30, 1982, for the purpose of
7 funding public projects in the State of Ponape. The sum
8 appropriated shall be apportioned in the following manner:

9 (1) Kitti Municipality for transportation, infrastructure,
10 and farmers' aid

11 (a) Transportation equipment \$15,000

12 (b) Channels, farm roads, classrooms,
13 school supplies, economic development projects
14 assistance, and summer training 55,000

15 (2) Madolenihmw Municipality for transportation,
16 infrastructure, and farmers' aid

17 (a) Economic development projects, classrooms,
18 farm roads, causeway, and summer training 20,000

19 (b) Sapwerek elementary classrooms 9,000

20 (c) Nansohli water system 1,000

21 (d) Diadi water system 1,000

22 (e) Kitamw water system 1,000

23 (f) Lohd Pah water system 1,000

24 (g) Lohd Powe bridge 1,000
