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A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1 and 7 of Public Law No. 3-18 to add seven positions to the Department of Finance and one position, a Deputy Attorney General, to the Office of the Attorney General, and to appropriate funds for the position of Deputy Attorney General, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 3-18 is hereby amended to  
2 read as follows:

3 "Section 1. Operating expenses of the executive branch. The  
4 sum of \$1,024,100, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is  
5 hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated  
6 States of Micronesia, and the sum of ~~\$4,523,574~~ \$4,557,874,  
7 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated  
8 from the United States Grant Special Fund for the fiscal year  
9 ending September 30, 1984, for the operations of the executive  
10 branch of the National Government of the Federated States of  
11 Micronesia during fiscal year 1984. The sums appropriated  
12 by this section shall be apportioned as follows:


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(2) The number of positions authorized applies individually to each of the departments and offices of the executive and legislative branches, the National judiciary, the Public Auditor, and to the agencies as provided in subsection (1) of this section, except that the President may transfer up to 12 positions between the departments and offices of the executive branch. This authorization of positions covers all permanent employees, all contract personnel whose employment extends for 1 year or more, and all positions funded from United States federal programs. No funds may be expended for unbudgeted positions."

Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
