

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 7 of Public Law No. 3-18, as amended by Public Law No. 3-39, to increase the employment ceiling for the National judiciary of the Federated States of Micronesia from 19 to 20 employees, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 7 of Public Law No. 3-18, as amended by Public
2 Law No. 3-39, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 7. Employment ceilings. Subsection (1) sets forth
4 the maximum number of positions that may be hired by branches
5 and agencies of the National Government.

18 each of the departments and offices of the executive and legisla-
19 tive branches, the National judiciary, the Public Auditor, and
20 to the agencies as provided in subsection (1) of this section,
21 except that the President may transfer up to 12 positions between
22 the departments and offices of the executive branch. This
23 authorization of positions covers all permanent employees, all
24 contract personnel whose employment extends for 1 year or more,
25 and all positions funded from United States federal programs. No

1 funds may be expended for unbudgeted positions."

2 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the President
3 of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without
4 such approval.
