

A RESOLUTION

Expressing deepest sympathy and condolences to the family and friends and to the people of Pingelap and Ponape for the passing of Albert Diopulos.

1 WHEREAS, on May 9, 1983, Albert Diopulos, a prominent teacher
2 and reverend of Ponape and Pingelap, finally lost his long battle
3 with diabetes and kidney problems; and

4 WHEREAS, in recognition of his long and distinguished career as
5 an educational and spiritual leader, the late Albert Diopulos' death
6 will bereave all who knew him; and

7 WHEREAS, Albert Diopulos received an Outstanding Service Award
8 in 1979 for his educational efforts on the Marshall Islands; and

9 WHEREAS, Albert Diopulos was one of the traditional leaders of
10 the people of Pingelap; and

11 WHEREAS, Albert Diopulos' life did honor to the ideal of spiritual
12 and educational leadership and public service; and

13 WHEREAS, Albert Diopulos dedicated his life to the pursuit of
14 spiritual and educational ideals and will be a shining example to
15 all who seek to serve their people; now, therefore,

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States
17 of Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1983, that the Congress expresses
18 its sorrow, deepest sympathy, and condolences to the family and friends of
19 the late Albert Diopulos; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution
21 be transmitted to the family and children of the late Albert Diopulos,
22 the Nanmwarki of Pingelap, and the Chairman of Pwihnen Apwapwalih.
