

A RESOLUTION

Expressing the profound shock and anger of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia over the cold-blooded destruction of a Korean Airlines Boeing 747 jetliner on September 1, 1983, by a Soviet fighter-plane-launched missile.

1 WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia was
2 shocked and angered over the cold-blooded destruction of a Korean Airlines
3 Boeing 747 jetliner on September 1, 1983, by a Soviet fighter-plane-
4 launched missile; and

5 WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia reacted
6 with revulsion to the barbarous act of the Soviet Union of wantonly
7 taking 269 innocent and precious lives; and

8 WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia condemns
9 the savage, inhumane air massacre committed by the Soviet Union; and

10 WHEREAS, the Soviet Union has deliberately failed to publicly
11 apologize to the bereaved families or to make just and full compensation
12 for all losses incurred, thereby adding further insult to injury; now,
13 therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of
15 Micronesia, Second Regular Session, 1983, that the Congress expresses its
16 profound shock and anger over the cold-blooded destruction of a Korean
17 Airlines Boeing 747 jetliner on September 1, 1983, by a Soviet fighter-
18 plane-launched missile; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be
20 transmitted to the Honorable Yuri Andropov, General Secretary of the
21 Soviet Communist Party Central Committee; the Honorable Ronald Reagan,
22 President of the United States; the Honorable George Schultz, Secretary
