

A RESOLUTION

Expressing appreciation to those individuals and institutions responsible for organizing and conducting the recently completed training program for Micronesian Public Safety Officers at the Micronesian Police Academy in Sitka, Alaska.

1 WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia is continuously striving
2 to develop its manpower, setting as its goals increased self-reliance
3 and improved social well-being for its citizens; and

4 WHEREAS, a number of Federated States of Micronesia State and
5 National public safety officers recently attended an intensive 13-week
6 training program at the Alaska Department of Public Safety Academy in
7 Sitka, Alaska, which for the purposes of the program was known as the
8 Micronesian Police Academy; and

9 WHEREAS, the above-mentioned training program involved a rigorous
10 course of study designed to develop the skills and abilities of the
11 participants in essential public safety activities; and

12 WHEREAS, Bryan Vila of the Trust Territory Bureau of Investigation
13 and Ron Reynolds, former Chief of Police for Yap State, were primarily
14 responsible for organizing the training program and contributed
15 considerable time, energy, and support to ensure its successful imple-
16 mentation; and

17 WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Public Safety generously provided
18 the facilities and instructors for the training program; and

19 WHEREAS, the successful completion of the training program by the
20 public safety officers testifies to the efforts of Mr. Vila and Mr. Reynolds,
21 and the Alaska Department of Public Safety; and

22 WHEREAS, the training program should result in improved, more self-
23 reliant public safety services for the people of the Federated States
24 of Micronesia; now, therefore,

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of

1 Micronesia, Second Regular Session, 1983, that the Congress expresses its
2 sincere appreciation to Bryan Vila and Ron Reynolds for their efforts in
3 organizing the training program and helping to realize its successful
4 completion; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Congress expresses its sincere
6 appreciation to the Alaska Department of Public Safety for its generosity,
7 and support in providing the facilities and instructors needed for the
8 training program; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be
10 transmitted to Bryan Vila, Ron Reynolds, the Director of the Alaska
11 Department of Public Safety, the President of the Federated States of
12 Micronesia, the High Commissioner of the Trust Territory of the Pacific
13 Islands, the Governor of each State, and the chief public safety officer
14 of each State.
