Expressing deepest concern and distress over the serious illness of Speaker Joseph Ayin of the Yap State Legislature and wishing him a speedy recovery.

1 WHEREAS, Speaker Joseph Ayin of the Yap State Legislature recently  
2 suffered from a serious illness; and

3 WHEREAS, this serious illness resulted in Speaker Ayin being  
4 evacuated to the Naval Hospital on Guam; and

5 WHEREAS, it is the sense of the Congress of the Federated States  
6 of Micronesia that the fledgling governments of the Federated States  
7 of Micronesia need the energy and dedication of public servants like  
8 Speaker Ayin; now, therefore,


9 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of
