A RESOLUTION

Acknowledging the vital role that the Hawaii Job Corps Center has played in the manpower development of the Federated States of Micronesia and expressing sincere and profound appreciation to the Hawaii Job Corps Center and the staff thereof for playing such a vital role in this young Nation's development.

1 WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia at the present time does
2 not have enough vocational training institutions to accommodate the training
3 and manpower needs of this young Nation; and

4 WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia has depended to a large
5 extent on sending its young trainees abroad to learn the essential trades
6 and crafts that are needed by this young Nation; and

7 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Job Corps Center has been one of the few
8 institutions that has trained FSM citizens to attain a high degree of
9 knowledge and expertise in their respective vocational fields; and

10 WHEREAS, most of the graduates of the Hawaii Job Corps Center have
11 exhibited outstanding knowledge and expertise in their fields of
12 endeavor; and

13 WHEREAS, the Governments and the private sector of the Federated
14 States of Micronesia are very pleased with the performance of the Hawaii
15 Job Corps Center graduates; and

16 WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia feels it
17 is appropriate to express the sincere and profound appreciation of the
18 Congress to the Hawaii Job Corps Center and the staff thereof for the
19 important role they play in the manpower development of this young
20 Nation; now, therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of
22 Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 1984, that this Congress acknowledges
23 the vital role the Hawaii Job Corps Center has played in the manpower
24 development of the Federated States of Micronesia and, at the same time,
25 expresses this Congress's sincere and profound appreciation to the Hawaii
