A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend title 50 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia by adding a new section 113 for the purpose of establishing the Passport Revolving Fund, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Title 50 of the Code of the Federated States of
2	Micronesia is hereby amended by adding a new section 113 to read as
3	follows:
4	"Section 113. Passport Revolving Fund.
5	(1) There is hereby created and established the
6	Passport Revolving Fund, hereinafter referred to as the
7	"Fund," separate from the General Fund of the Federated
8	States of Micronesia and all other funds.
9	(2) The purpose of the Fund is to establish an
10	ongoing revolving fund to allow appropriations for, and
11	revenues from, the issuance and renewal of passports to
12	be used for passport issuance and renewal.
13	(3) All future appropriations for, and revenues
14	received from, the issuance and renewal of passports
15	shall be deposited in the Fund. Any unexpended monies
16	in this Fund shall not revert to the General Fund nor
17	lapse at the end of the fiscal year.
18	(4) The Fund shall be administered by the Chief
19	of the Division of Immigration. The Chief shall, not
20	later than thirty days after the close of each govern-
21	mental fiscal year, submit to the Attorney General a
22	complete report of the activities and condition of the
23	Fund for the fiscal year just closed. The Attorney
24	General shall, within thirty days of receipt of the
25	report from the Chief, forward the report to the

1	President and the Congress of the Federated States of
2	Micronesia.
3	(5) The Public Auditor shall audit the Fund at
4	such times as the Public Auditor deems appropriate."
5	Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
6	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
7	becoming law without such approval.
