Any graduate of an accredited law school who is a 1 citizen of the Federated States of Micronesia and who has practiced law 3 within the Federated States of Micronesia for at least 2 years prior, 4 or subsequent, to graduation from law school, is hereby exempted 5 from the requirement of taking the written bar examination of the Supreme 6 Court of the Federated States of Micronesia before being admitted to 7 practice law before that Court.
