## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To authorize the President of the Federated States of Micronesia to recognize diplomatic agents to serve within the Federated States of Micronesia and to provide immunity from suit for those individuals, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Recognition of diplomatic agents. The President 2
- of the Federated States of Micronesia is authorized to, and shall,
- 3 recognize any ambassador or public minister of a foreign country
- who shall serve as a diplomatic agent in the Federated States of 4
- 5 Micronesia. The designated person shall be granted diplomatic
- 6 status.
- 7 Section 2. Immunity granted to diplomatic agents. Any such
- 8 person designated as a diplomatic agent pursuant to section 1, and
- his family, employees, and domestic servants, shall be immune to 9
- 10 any civil or criminal proceeding or suit by any court of the
- Federated States of Micronesia, its States, or any subdivision 11
- within a State. Any of these courts shall not cause to be 12
- 13 arrested, prosecuted, or imprisoned any recognized diplomatic agent
- or seize, distrain, or attach his property. Any such action named 14
- in this section shall be deemed void. 15
- Section 3. Exceptions to immunity. Section 2 shall not apply 16
- 17 to any of the following individuals:
- (1) A person who is, at the time he is served with a 18 legal action, a citizen or inhabitant of the Federated States 19
- 20 of Micronesia, who is in the service of an ambassador or a
- public minister, and the legal action is based on a debt 21
- contracted prior to his recognition pursuant to section 1 as a 22
- diplomatic agent. 23
- 24 (2) A person who is a domestic servant or employee of an
- ambassador or a public minister, unless the name of the 25
