## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by amending section 103 for the purpose of designating an earlier date for the submittal by the President of the proposed annual budget of the National Government, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 103 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated
- 2 States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 "Section 103. Annual budget.

- (1) All proposed appropriations and expenditures for the ensuing fiscal year for the executive branch, Congress, the judicial branch, the Public Auditor, and agencies of the National Government shall be transmitted to the President on or before April 1 March 15 of each year. Appropriations and expenditures proposed by Congress, the judicial branch, the Public Auditor, and agencies of the National Government shall be included in the proposed annual budget by the President without revision.
- (2) The President shall submit thirty copies of the proposed annual budget of the National Government for the ensuing fiscal year to Congress no later than May 1 April 15 of each year.
- (3) The President shall submit, with the proposed annual budget, a budget message, and recommendations which the public interest may require, summary data and text, and supporting detail. The proposed annual budget also shall set forth in such form and detail as the President may determine or as the Congress may require by law:
- (a) proposed appropriations and expenditures necessary for the support of the National Government for the ensuing fiscal year;

1 (b) anticipated revenues and other money to be 2 made available to the National Government from all sources 3 in the ensuing fiscal year, including, but not limited to, taxes, fees, fines, interest income, revenue from fishing 4 5 agreements, United States grant funds, United States Federal 6 programs, reimbursements, and loans; (c) if the total of the proposed appropriations 7 8 and expenditures exceeds the total of the funds estimated 9 to be available for appropriation during the ensuing fiscal 10 year, recommendations as to how the deficiency is to be met, either through additional revenues or reduced appropriations 11 12 and expenditures; 13 (d) statements of the balance of the General Fund and any special funds of the National Treasury for the 14 fiscal year last concluded, including the actual revenue 15 by source, all appropriations, and the obligations 16 17 and expenditures pursuant to each appropria-18 tion; (e) statements of the projected balance of the 19 General Fund and any special funds of the National Treasury 20 for the fiscal year in progress including all appropria-21 tions, estimated revenues by source, and anticipated 22 23 obligations. If the projected balance for any fund indicates a deficit, recommendations as to how the 24 25 deficiency is to be met;

(f) details of all budget requests to be submitted 1 to the United States Government for the fiscal year which 2 next follows in the ensuing fiscal year; 3 (g) details of all economic development projects 4 to be funded or undertaken by the National Government in the 5 ensuing fiscal year, relating such projects to goals and 6 objectives set forth in planning documents of the National 7 Government; and 8 (h) such other financial information and data as 9 may be necessary or desirable in order to make known in 10 reasonable and practicable detail the financial condition 11 of the National Government." 12 Section 2.
