A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$220,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1987, for the purpose of funding public projects in Madolenihmw and Kitti Municipalities, State of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. The sum of \$220,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1987, for the purpose of funding public projects in Madolenihmw and Kitti Municipalities, State of Pohnpei. 5 Section 2. The sum appropriated under section 1 of this act 6 shall be apportioned as follows: 7 (1) Madolenihmw public projects..... \$ 110,000 110,000. (2) Kitti public projects..... 9 Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be 10 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds appropriated under 13 subsection (1) of section 2 shall be the Menin Keder lapalap of the 14 Madolenihmw municipal government. The allottee of the funds 15 appropriated under subsection (2) of section 2 shall be the Luhken 16 Menlap of the Kitti municipal government. The allottees shall be 17 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may 18 be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, 19 and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum 20 appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1987. 22 23
