A RESOLUTION

Expressing appreciation to Congressman Ben Blaz of Guam for his continuing support of the aspirations of the people of the Federated States of Micronesia, as demonstrated by his efforts to obtain expeditious passage of the Compact of Free Association by the U.S. Congress.

- WHEREAS, the Compact of Free Association and its related agreements
- 2 are now pending before the U.S. Congress, which must approve them before
- 3 they can take effect; and
- WHEREAS, recently-elected Congressman Ben Blaz of Guam is a member
- 5 of the U.S. House of Representatives Committee on Interior and Insular
- 6 Affairs, which is one of the U.S. congressional committees reviewing the
- 7 Compact of Free Association and its related agreements; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Congressman Blaz, in his maiden address on the floor of the
- 9 U.S. House of Representatives, strongly supported the aspirations of the
- 10 people of the Federated States of Micronesia, by noting that Micronesians
- ll have established constitutional governments "in anticipation of taking
- 12 their rightful place on the world scene"; and
- WHEREAS, Congressman Blaz further noted in response to criticism of
- 14 the Compact of Free Association and its related agreements that, "I have
- 15 heard no concern expressed by anyone which would justify undue delay in
- 16 approving and implementing the Compact," and that "it would be a violation
- 17 of [the United States'] commitment to Micronesian self-determination to
- 18 use the agreement as a vehicle for addressing other partisan issues"; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Congressman Blaz further stated that "the Compact's Incen-
- 20 tives for development in Micronesia will produce regional political and
- 21 economic development which will directly benefit the United States and
- 22 its Pacific territories"; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Congressman Blaz further noted that "the Compact presents
- 24 the United States with a historic opportunity to show the Pacific community
- 25 that we will enter the next century in a strong strategic posture, but also

- 1 as a nation able to build good will in the region through creative
- 2 and democratic arrangements oriented toward economic development
- 3 through private enterprise"; and
- WHEREAS, Congressman Blaz concluded his eloquent address by
- 5 stating that, "The Micronesians have come of age and are ready to ful-
- 6 fill their own destiny. We [in the U.S. Congress] have an obligation
- 7 to facilitate their desire to do so. Forty years after we assumed
- 8 trusteeship of their islands, we must remind ourselves that we are their
- 9 guardians, not the guards of Micronesia."; and
- WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia is
- 11 grateful for Congressman Blaz' sensitive and articulate support of self-
- 12 determination for the people of the Federated States of Micronesia, and
- 13 in particular for his stirring remarks in support of expeditious approval
- 14 of the Compact of Free Association and its related agreements; now,
- 15 therefore,
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Fourth Congress of the Federated States of Micro-
- 17 nesia, First Regular Session, 1985, that the Congress hereby expresses its
- 18 appreciation to Congressman Ben Blaz of Guam for his continuing support
- 19 of the aspirations of the people of the Federated States of Micronesia,
- 20 as demonstrated by his efforts to obtain expeditious passage of the
- 21 Compact of Free Association by the U.S. Congress; and
- 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be
- 23 transmitted to Congressman Ben Blaz and the Speaker of the U.S. House of
