A RESOLUTION

Respectfully requesting the President of the Federated States of Micronesia to formulate and deliver to the Congress a non-Compact level National budget for fiscal year 1986, utilizing Department of Interior and local revenue sources, which will be designed toward fostering independence from the United States as a viable alternative as soon as possible.

- 1 WHEREAS, the people of the Federated States of Micronesia freely
- 2 chose to enter into free association with the United States under a
- 3 Compact of Free Association negotiated by the Federated States of
- 4 Micronesia and the United States; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the United States House of Representatives is now
- 6 considering amendments to the Compact of Free Association which would
- 7 materially alter the Compact in a manner that could make the Compact
- 8 unacceptable to the Federated States of Micronesia; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the actions of the United States House of Representatives
- 10 may compel the Federated States of Micronesia to consider other
- 11 alternatives for our Nation's political status, including indepen-
- 12 dence; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the President of the Federated States of Micronesia has
- 14 recently submitted to this Congress a fiscal year 1986 National
- 15 budget based upon Compact level funding, which may not be available; and
- 16 WHEREAS, this budget proposes massive increases in Government
- 17 spending, which would increase our dependence on the United States and
- 18 thereby limit our future political status options; now, therefore,
- 19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Fourth Congress of the Federated States of
- 20 Micronesia, First Special Session, 1985, that the Congress hereby
- 21 respectfully requests the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
- 22 to formulate and deliver to the Congress a non-Compact level National
- 23 budget for fiscal year 1986, utilizing Department of Interior and local
- 24 revenue sources, which will be designed toward fostering independence
- 25 from the United States as a viable alternative as soon as possible; and
