5	the Congress; and

7	other agencies and departments of the National Government through the
8	economic and efficient administration of its own operational accounts;
9	and
10	WHEREAS, a complete audit of all Congress accounts would indicate
11	whether they are being properly managed; now, therefore,
12	BE IT RESOLVED by the Second Congress of the Federated States of
13	Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 1982, that the Public Auditor is
14	requested to give the highest priority to auditing the accounts of
15	the Congress; and
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution
17	be transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia,
18	the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia, and the
19	Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia.
