

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 10 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 2-61 and 3-4, by amending further section 101, as amended by Public Law No. 2-61; by amending further sections 102 and 103, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 2-61 and 3-4 for the purpose of changing the Federated States of Micronesia Representative Office to the Federated States of Micronesia Diplomatic Mission to the United States; to change the Representative to the Federated States of Micronesia Ambassador to the United States; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 101 of title 10 of the Code of the Federated
2 States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 2-61, is hereby further
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 101. Office established. There shall be an office
5 to be known as the Federated States of Micronesia ~~Representative~~
6 ~~Office~~ Diplomatic Mission to the United States to be located in
7 Washington, District of Columbia, United States of America,
8 which shall be under the direct supervision of ~~a Representative~~
9 the Federated States of Micronesia Ambassador to the United
10 States in accordance with the provisions of this chapter. The
11 ~~Representative~~ Ambassador shall be appointed by the President of
12 the Federated States of Micronesia, with the advice and consent
13 of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia. The
14 ~~Representative~~ Ambassador serves at the pleasure of the President."

15 Section 2. Section 102 of title 10 of the Code of the Federated States
16 of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 2-61 and 3-4, is hereby
17 further amended to read as follows:

18 "Section 102. Representative Ambassador-Powers and duties. The
19 ~~Representative~~ Ambassador shall maintain the office headquarters
20 in Washington, D.C., and shall have the power to employ such
21 secretarial, clerical, technical, and professional assistance
22 as he may deem necessary to the fulfilling of his duties and
23 responsibilities, subject to appropriations for his office. He
24 shall represent the people of the Federated States of Micronesia
25 on a full-time basis before the Congress of the United States and

1 before the various departments and agencies of the Federal
2 Government and other organizations, public and private, on all
3 matters pertaining to the Federated States of Micronesia, and
4 shall actively and fully advocate all programs and policies duly
5 adopted by the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia.
6 He shall also assist the public officials of the Federated
7 States of Micronesia with respect to all matters necessary and
8 pertaining to the conduct of their offices, and shall render a
9 written report on his activities to the Secretary of the
10 Department of External Affairs once a year during the first
11 regular session of the Congress of the Federated States of Micro-
12 nesia of each calendar year beginning in 1981. The Secretary shall
13 forthwith deliver the report to the Congress of the Federated
14 States of Micronesia. The ~~Representative~~ Ambassador shall be
15 subject to the direction of the President of the Federated States
16 of Micronesia on the conduct of his office and shall submit a
17 monthly report of his activities to him."

18 Section 3. Section 103 of title 10 of the Code of the Federated
19 States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 2-61 and 3-4, is
20 hereby further amended to read as follows:

21 "Section 103. Representative Ambassador-Compensation. The
22 ~~Representative~~ Ambassador shall be paid an annual salary of
23 \$24,000, which salary shall not be diminished during his tenure
24 of office. In addition thereto, he shall receive an allowance
25 each fiscal year for secretarial, clerical, technical, and

1 professional assistance, and for all office expenses, including
 2 office rental and equipment, and such other and further expenses
 3 as may be allowed by the Congress of the Federated States of
 4 Micronesia by appropriation. The ~~Representative~~ Ambassador
 5 and his family shall be permitted one paid round trip from
 6 Washington to the Federated States of Micronesia every two years
 7 in addition to his own travel on official business. He shall
 8 be entitled to the same benefits as the members of the cabinet
 9 of the President. For travel on official business he shall be
 10 entitled to receive the standard Federated States of Micronesia
 11 rates of per diem and actual travel costs."

12 Section 4. This act shall take effect upon the occurrence of all of
 13 the following:

14 (1) Upon becoming law upon approval by the President of the
 15 Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such
 16 approval;

17 (2) Upon the taking of effect of the Compact of Free Association
 18 between the Federated States of Micronesia and the United States of America;
 19 and

20 (3) Upon the consent of the United States of America to the
 21 establishment of a permanent Federated States of Micronesia diplomatic mission
 22 within the United States of America.
