A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend section 103 of title 50 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia relating to short-term contracts, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 103 of title 50 of the Code of the Federated
2 States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 103. Entry permits-Types.

4 (1) A permit is not required for a person visiting for
5 thirty days or less. For a visit in excess of thirty days a
6 permit may be issued for an additional period not to exceed sixty
7 days.

8 (2) A visitor's permit for any lawful purpose, including
9 performance of necessary services to the Government
10 on a short-term contractual basis, may be
11 issued for a period of specified duration reflecting the time
12 necessary to accomplish the purpose.

13 (3) An alien worker's permit shall be issued to a nonciti-
14 zen entering the Federated States of Micronesia upon compliance
15 with all National laws relating to private or governmental
16 employment for the period in which the employment of the alien
17 worker is authorized by contract. The permit shall be renewed
18 upon extension or renewal of the alien's lawful employment status.

19 (4) A foreign investor's entry permit shall be issued for a
20 specified duration and may be renewed upon renewal or extension
21 of such foreign investor's business permit.

22 (5) A researcher's entry permit shall be issued for research
23 in the fields of endeavor that the President deems in the best
24 interest of and for the well-being of the citizens of the Federated
25 States of Micronesia; provided that the President receives from

1 the researcher's intended place of stay prior permission for his
2 entry. The President may attach thereto such conditions or
3 restrictions as he deems necessary.

4 (6) A missionary's permit shall be issued to a duly ordained,
5 licensed, and certified minister or clergyman. A missionary's
6 permit may also be issued to persons whose activities are sub-
7 stantially connected with religious or missionary work as determined
8 by the President.

9 (7) An entry permit shall be issued to a lawful spouse of
10 a citizen. The permit shall be revoked or shall be denied upon
11 a finding that the parties are divorced or irreconcilably separated,
12 or that the citizen-spouse is deceased. The President or his
13 designee has the authority to grant or reissue the permit for
14 indefinite duration upon a finding of hardship.

15 (8) A dependent's entry permit may be issued to an unmarried
16 child, under the age of eighteen, or a noncitizen spouse subject
17 to the conditions in subsection (7) of this section.

18 (9) A spouse or unmarried child under the age of eighteen of
19 any noncitizen principal listed in this section except subsection
20 (8) may be issued an entry permit for the duration of the
21 principal's entry permit and may be renewed upon renewal of the
22 principal's entry permit."


