A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 10 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by adding a new chapter 7 concerning the Foreign Affairs Advisory Council; to appropriate the sum of \$9,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1987, for the purpose of funding the travel necessary for Council meetings; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
1	Section 1. Title 10 of the Code of the Federated States of
2	Micronesia is hereby further amended by adding a new section 701
3	of chapter 7 to read as follows:
4	"Section 701. Foreign Affairs Advisory Council - Creation
5	There is hereby created the Foreign Affairs Advisory
6	Council."
7	Section 2. Title 10 of the Code of the Federated States of
8	Micronesia is hereby further amended by adding a new section 702
9	of chapter 7 to read as follows:
10	"Section 702. Foreign Affairs Advisory Council - Meetings
11	The Foreign Affairs Advisory Council shall meet with
12	officials from the Federated States of Micronesia
13	Department of External Affairs for the purpose of
14	consultations and exchanges of views. The Council shall
15	meet at times mutually agreed upon by the Council and the
16	Department."
17	Section 3. Title 10 of the Code of the Federated States of
18	Micronesia is hereby further amended by adding a new section 703
19	of chapter 7 to read as follows:
20	"Section 703. Foreign Affairs Advisory Council - Members.
21	The Foreign Affairs Advisory Council shall consist of one
22	member from each State of the Federated States of Micro-
23	nesia appointed jointly by the Governor and Speaker of the
24	State legislature of that State. Members shall serve at

the pleasure of their respective Governors, although if

1	a member is replaced the replacement must be by joint
2	appointment. If a member is unable to attend a meeting
3	of the Council, the Governor and Speaker may jointly
4	appoint an alternate to attend in his place."
5	Section 4. Title 10 of the Code of the Federated States of
6	Micronesia is hereby further amended by adding a new section 704 of
7	chapter 7 to read as follows:
8	"Section 704. Foreign Affairs Advisory Council - Expenses
9	and compensation. Members of the Foreign Affairs Advisory
10	Council shall be entitled to necessary travel expenses and
11	to per diem at standard Federated States of Micronesia
12	rates while on the business of the Council. Council
13	members who are neither employees nor officials of the
14	National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia
15	or any State government shall, in addition, be paid \$30
16	per day while on the business of the Council. If a member
17	of the Council is concurrently employed in another post
18	in the Federated States of Micronesia National Government,
19	he shall be granted leave to attend meetings of the
20	Council, and shall receive his regular salary while on
21	the business of the Council."
22	Section 5. The sum of \$9,000, or so much thereof as may be
23	necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
24	Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September
25	30, 1987, for the purpose of funding the travel necessary for Foreign

1 Affairs Advisory Council meetings. Section 6. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial 5 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for 6 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, 7 are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no 8 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act 10 shall lapse as of September 30, 1987. 11 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the 12 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming 13 law without such approval. 14 Introduced by: Elias H. Heomon
