A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$14,112,896 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1988, for the operations of the executive branch, legislative branch, National judiciary, Public Auditor, agencies of the National Government, and for special programs, grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds of the National Government during fiscal year 1988; to establish a development budget and to appropriate special funds available therefor under the Compact of Free Association; to establish budgets for Compact sections 215(a)(2), 216(a)(1), 216(a)(2), and 221(b) programs and to appropriate special funds available therefor under the Compact; to establish employment ceilings; and for other purposes.

6	Section 14. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.
7	All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
8	administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law,
9	including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979,
10	as amended. Each allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that
11	these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely
12	for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are
13	incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the
14	allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
15	of September 30, 1988.
16	Section 15. Effective date. This act shall become law upon
17	approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
18	upon its becoming law without such approval.
