A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 5-16, by adding a new subchapter V of chapter 6 for the purpose of creating a Search and Rescue Fund; to appropriate the sum of \$100,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1988, for the purpose of funding the Search and Rescue Fund; and for other purposes.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:	
1	Section 1. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of	
2	3 subchapter V of chapter 6 to read as follows:

5	(1) There is created a Search and Rescue Fund to be	
6	used for search and rescue operations at sea within the	
7	territorial sea and exclusive economic zone of the Federated	
8	States of Micronesia and adjacent international waters.	
9	(2) Moneys for the Search and Rescue Fund shall be	
10	derived from appropriations by the Congress of the Federated	
11	States of Micronesia and from any and all other appropriate	
12	sources.	
13	(3) The Search and Rescue Fund shall be administered	
14	in accordance with the provisions of this subchapter."	
15	Section 2. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of	
16	Micronesia is hereby further amended by adding a new section 624 of	
17	subchapter V of chapter 6 to read as follows:	
18	"Section 624. Request - Use of Search and Rescue Fund.	
19	(1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this	
20	section, all requests for assistance from the Search and	
21	Rescue Fund shall be made to the President by the Governor	
22	of a State of the Federated States of Micronesia or the	
23	secretary or head of an appropriate department, office, or	
24	agency of the National Government of the Federated States of	
25	Micronesia. Such request shall be based on the requester's

1	finding that a situation requiring search and rescue at sea
2	is beyond the capabilities of the requester's State
3	government or department, office, or agency, and that
4	assistance from the Search and Rescue Fund is necessary.
5	Such requests will include information describing efforts
6	and resources the requester has or will use in the search
7	and rescue operation, and will define the type and extent
8	of aid from the Search and Rescue Fund required.
9	(2) A request for assistance from the Search and
LO	Rescue Fund may be made by a foreign government if its
L1	citizens or a vessel under its flag require search and
L2	rescue assistance within the territorial sea or exclusive
L3	economic zone of the Federated States of Micronesia or
L4	adjacent international waters. Nothing in this section
L5	shall be construed as preventing the President from seeking
L6	reimbursement from the foreign governments for expenditures

L8	(3) Upon determining that a need for assistance from
L9	the Search and Rescue Fund exists, the President may

23	Section 3. The sum of \$100,000, or so much there of as may be
24	necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the

1	30, 1988, for the purpose of funding the Search and Rescue Fund.
2	Section 4. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
3	managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable
4	law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
5	1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
6	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the
7	purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in
8	excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottee to
9	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse.
10	Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
11	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
12	law without such approval.
