A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 3-56, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 3-71, 4-8, 4-49, and 4-80, to reallocate funds for certain public projects, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 3-56, as amended by  
2   Public Laws Nos. 3-71, 4-8, 4-49, and 4-80, is hereby further  
3   amended to read as follows:

4             "Section 1. The sum of \$789,700, or so much thereof as  
5       may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General  
6       Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
7       year ending September 30, 1985, for the purpose of funding  
8       public projects in the State of Truk. The sum appropriated  
9       herein shall be apportioned as follows:

10           (1) Truk state-wide projects  
11              (a) Purchase of hospital medical  
12               supplies and equipment..... \$ 20,000  
13              (b) Purchase of Truk  
14               dispensaries' medical supplies and equipment... 10,000  
15              (c) Purchase of Mortlock Super  
16               Dispensary medical supplies and equipment..... 5,000  
17              (d) Purchase of dental supplies  
18               and equipment..... 5,000  
19              (e) Purchase of a cargo and  
20               passenger boat for the Upper Mortlocks..... 60,000  
21              (f) Projects and operations funds

24              (g) Projects and operations funds for  
25               the Outer Faichuk Development Authority (PWP).. 8,250




