FIFTH CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

FOURTH REGULAR SESSION, 1988 CONGRESSIONAL BILL No. 5-378, C.D.1, C.D.2,  
C.D.3, C.D.4

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AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 5-67 by amending section 2 to allocate funds appropriated therein, by amending section 3 to modify the designation of allottees, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 5-67 is hereby amended  
2 to read as follows:

Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 5-67 is hereby amended  
to read as follows:

"Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in  
accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited  
to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of  
the funds appropriated under sub-paragraphs (a), (b), (c),  
(d), (e), (f), and (g) of subsection (1) of section 2 of  
this act shall be the Governor of the State of Pohnpei.  
The allottee of the funds appropriated under sub-paragraph  
(h) of subsection (1) of section 2 of this act, and under  
sub-paragraphs (d)(ii), (e), (f), (g), (h) and (k)(ii) of  
subsection (2) of section 2 of this act shall be the  
Pohnpei Community Action Agency. The allottee of the funds  
appropriated under sub-paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of  
section 2 of this act shall be the Menin Keder Lapalap of  
the Madolenihmw Municipal Government, except for those  
funds appropriated under sub-paragraph (a)(xxxiv) of  
subsection (2) of section 2 of this act for which the  
allottee shall be the Representative of the Municipality of

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1                   Madolenihmw to the Congress of the Federated States of  
2                   Micronesia. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
3                   sub-paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section 2 of this  
4                   act shall be the Luhken Menlap of the Kitti Municipal  
5                   Government, except for those funds appropriated under  
6                   sub-paragraph (b)(iv)(f) of subsection (2) of section 2 of  
7                   this act for which the allottee shall be the Representative  
8                   of the Municipality of Kitti to the Congress of the  
9                   Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee of the funds  
10                  appropriated under sub-paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of  
11                  section 2 of this act shall be the Kolonia Town Mayor. The  
12                  allottee of the funds appropriated under sub-paragraph  
13                  (d)(i) of subsection (2) of section 2 of this act shall be  
14                  the Chief Magistrate of the Sokehs Municipal Government.  
15                  The allottee of the funds appropriated under sub-paragraph  
16                  (i) of subsection (2) of section 2 of this act shall be the  
17                  Luhkenkolwof of Sapwuahfik. The allottee of the funds  
18                  appropriated under sub-paragraph (j) of subsection (2) of  
19                  section 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of the  
20                  Nukuoro Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds  
21                  appropriated under sub-paragraph (k)(i) of subsection (2)  
22                  of section 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of  
23                  the Kapingamarangi Municipal Government. The allottee of  
24                  the funds appropriated under subsection (3) of section 2 of  
25                  this act shall be the Chairman of the Pohnpei Congressional

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1           Delegation. Each allottee shall be responsible for  
2           ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be  
3           necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in  
4           this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of  
5           the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to  
6           obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of  
7           September 30, 1989."

8           Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
9           President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
10          becoming law without such approval.
