A RESOLUTION

Expressing the deepest appreciation and gratitude of the Congress and people of the Federated States of Micronesia to the beloved Reverend Hugh F. Costigan, S.J., by conferring upon him the title of "Honorary Citizen of the Federated States of Micronesia," in recognition of his many contributions and accomplishments, and his love, dedication and service in promoting the social, educational, economic and spiritual development of the Nation.

- 1 WHEREAS, in 1947, the Reverend Hugh F. Costigan, S.J., after his
- 2 ordination in the Phillipines, arrived in Tamwaroi, Madolenihmw,
- 3 Pohnpei, to begin his parish work at a small wooden church, with a
- 4 simple shack for a residence; and
- 5 WHEREAS, after his arrival he developed the area, and built roads
- 6 and facilities, molding Tamwaroi into one of the most successful
- 7 agricultural and educational centers in the Micronesian region; and
- 8 WHEREAS, in 1958, he formed the Madolenihmw Housing Cooperative,
- 9 which provided concrete block homes to hundreds of Pohnpeians,
- 10 Pingelapese and Kosraeans, and built 90 percent of all government
- 11 schools and teacher homes, in the process training a generation of
- 12 tradesman in Pohnpei; and
- 13 WHEREAS, to help foster economic development, he formed the
- 14 Madolenihmw Copra Cooperative Association in 1960, an organization to
- 15 help the people of Pohnpei store and sell their copra; and
- WHEREAS, he established the Community Leadership Training
- 17 Program in 1968, which provided countless elder Pohnpeians with the
- 18 management expertise, mechanical knowledge and scientific
- 19 agricultural skills required to operate cooperatives and
- 20 associations; and
- 21 WHEREAS, through his efforts the Ponape Agriculture Trade School
- 22 (PATS) was opened in 1965, a vocational high school where the raw and
- 23 God-given talents of youngsters from across Micronesia were developed
- 24 and refined; and
- 25 WHEREAS, the graduates of PATS are successful,

- 1 self-sustaining citizens throughout the region, contributing greatly
- 2 to their people and their new nations; and
- 3 WHEREAS, in order to make PATS financially secure, he
- 4 established the Foundation for Promotion of Economic, Agricultural
- 5 and Community Endeavors (PEACE), an organization in the United States
- 6 specifically dedicated to sustaining the work of PATS; and
- WHEREAS, of all the non-citizens who have made important
- 8 contributions to the Federated States of Micronesia, the Reverend
- 9 Hugh F. Costigan, S.J., has few peers, and his accomplishments and
- 10 contributions will always be cherished and remembered; and
- WHEREAS, it is the sense of the Members, in Congress assembled,
- 12 that due recognition, gratitude and appreciation must be given to the
- 13 tireless, unselfish efforts of the beloved Reverend Hugh F. Costigan,
- 14 S.J., for his 40 years of loving and devoted service to the people of
- 15 the Federated States of Micronesia; now, therefore,
- 16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Fifth Congress of the Federated States of
- 17 Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1987, that the Congress, on behalf
- 18 of the people of the Federated States of Micronesia, hereby expresses
- 19 its deepest appreciation and gratitude to the beloved Reverend Hugh
- 20 F. Costigan, S.J., and confers upon him the title of "Honorary
- 21 Citizen of the Federated States of Micronesia," in recognition of his
- 22 many contributions and accomplishments, and his love, dedication and
- 23 service in promoting the social, educational, economic and spiritual
- 24 development of the Nation; and
- 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution
