A RESOLUTION

Urging the President of the Federated States of Micronesia to make future funding of the College of Micronesia an immediate priority for his administration, and endeavor to work with the State governments to resolve the issue in the very near future.

- WHEREAS, in the Saipan Accords of 1983, the Presidents of the
- 2 Federated States of Micronesia, the Republic of the Marshall Islands
- 3 and the Republic of Palau pledged the support of their Governments for
- 4 a unified College of Micronesia system after termination of the
- 5 Trusteeship Agreement; and
- 6 WHEREAS, with the implementation of the Compacts of Free
- 7 Association for the Federated States of Micronesia and the Republic
- 8 of the Marshall Islands, the College of Micronesia is facing a
- 9 financial crisis due to the loss of United States Department of
- 10 Interior subsidies and the phase out of revenues from United States
- 11 post-secondary education student financial assistance programs; and
- 12 WHEREAS, with this impending financial crisis in mind, the
- 13 Congress, by Congressional Resolution No. 4-129, previously
- 14 requested President Tosiwo Nakayama of the Federated States of
- 15 Micronesia to expeditiously seek a summit meeting with the Presidents
- 16 of the Republics of the Marshall Islands and Palau in order to develop
- 17 a funding plan for the College during the Compact era; and
- WHEREAS, to deal with this matter, President Nakayama established
- 19 a staff-level working group, which has participated in two rounds
- 20 of negotiations with counterparts from the Republics of the Marshall
- 21 Islands and Palau; and
- WHEREAS, these negotiations have resulted in agreed principles
- 23 for a treaty on the subject of a unified College of Micronesia system
- 24 in the future; and
- 25 WHEREAS, under the terms of the agreed principles, the Federated

- 1 States of Micronesia's share of funding for the College will amount
- 2 to at least \$1.018 million in fiscal year 1988, and will likely be
- 3 higher; and
- WHEREAS, a draft treaty embodying the agreed principles and
- 5 other necessary provisions will soon be circulated among the three
- 6 Governments in the hope that a mutually-acceptable agreement can
- 7 be entered into and submitted for ratification in the near future; and
- 8 WHEREAS, despite progress on development of the treaty,
- 9 uncertainty remains as to how the Federated States of Micronesia
- 10 will fund any agreed share of the College's operational costs;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, in particular, the respective National and State
- 13 Government responsibilities for such funding are unresolved;
- 14 and
- WHEREAS, by way of example, the Chief Executives, in Amendment
- 16 No. 2 to the Memorandum of Understanding with respect to the
- 17 Division of Grant Assistance under the Compact of Free Association
- 18 among the National and State Governments of the Federated States of
- 19 Micronesia, have proposed that grants provided by the United States
- 20 pursuant to section 216(a)(3) of the Compact of Free Association
- 21 be divided among the State and National Governments for fiscal
- 22 year 1987, with the National Government's share of \$489,740 being
- 23 dedicated to support of the College, and with future fiscal year
- 24 apportionments to be determined by mutual agreement after
- 25 clarification of the College funding situation; and

,	WHEREAS, the next school year for the College begins in
1	August, and the current fiscal year ends soon thereafter; and
2	
3	WHEREAS, if the treaty on the College is to be ratified and
4	funding secured to meet the Federated States of Micronesia's
5	obligations under the treaty, such actions must therefore occur
6	in the very near future; and
7	WHEREAS, there is consequently a pressing need for the
8	National and State Governments of the Federated States of Micronesia
9	to expeditiously decide what their respective responsibilities for
10	funding the College will be, and how available resources, including
11	Compact section 216(a)(3) funds, will be applied to that purpose;
12	now, therefore,
13	BE IT RESOLVED by the Fifth Congress of the Federated States
14	of Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1987, that the Congress
15	hereby urges the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
16	to make future funding of the College of Micronesia an immediate
17	priority for his administration, and endeavor to work with the
18	State governments to resolve the issue in the very near future;
