A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$122,419 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1987, for the purpose of assisting the State of Truk to recover from an office fire which destroyed voter registration records by providing funds for the construction of an office building for the Truk State Department of Public Affairs and the reregistration of Truk State voters, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$122,419, or so much thereof as may be
2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
4 1987, for the purpose of assisting the State of Truk to recover from
5 an office fire which destroyed voter registration records by
6 providing funds for the construction of an office building for the
7 Truk State Department of Public Affairs and the reregistration of
8 Truk State voters.

9 Section 2. The sum appropriated under section 1 of this act
10 shall be apportioned as follows:

- 11 (1) Office building.....\$50,000
- 12 (2) Reregistration:
- 13 (a) Salary and fringe benefits..... 34,919
- 14 (b) Transportation..... 20,000
- 15 (c) Supplies and materials..... 7,500
- 16 (d) Equipment..... 10,000

17 Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
18 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
19 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
20 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for
21 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
22 are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no
23 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The
24 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act
25 shall not lapse.
