A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 50 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-25, 4-68, and 4-109, by further amending section 103, as amended by Public Law No. 4-109, relating to entry permits, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 103 of title 50 of the Code of the Federated  
2 States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 4-109, is hereby  
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 103. Entry permits - Types.

5 (1) A permit is not required for a person visiting  
6 for thirty days or less. For a visit in excess of thirty  
7 days a permit may be issued for an additional period not to  
8 exceed sixty days.

9 (2) A visitor's permit for any lawful purpose,  
10 including performance of necessary services to the Govern-  
11 ment on a short-term contractual basis, may be issued for a  
12 period of specified duration reflecting the time necessary  
13 to accomplish the purpose.

14 (3) Notwithstanding any provision of subsections  
15 (1) and (2) of this section, a person entering the Federated  
16 States of Micronesia for the purpose of engaging in business  
17 as a noncitizen peddler, as defined in section 501 of title  
18 32 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, shall  
19 be issued a peddler's permit.

20 (4) An alien worker's permit shall be issued to a  
21 noncitizen entering the Federated States of Micronesia upon  
22 compliance with all National laws relating to private or  
23 governmental employment for the period in which the employ-  
24 ment of the alien worker is authorized by contract. The  
25 permit shall be renewed upon extension or renewal of the



1 alien's lawful employment status.

2 (5) A foreign investor's entry permit shall be issued  
3 for a specified duration and may be renewed upon renewal or  
4 extension of such foreign investor's business permit.

5 (6) A researcher's entry permit shall be issued for  
6 research in the fields of endeavor that the President deems  
7 in the best interest of and for the well-being of the  
8 citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia; provided  
9 that the President receives from the researcher's intended  
10 place of stay prior permission for his entry. The President  
11 may attach thereto such conditions or restrictions as he  
12 deems necessary.

13 (7) A missionary's permit shall be issued to a duly  
14 ordained, licensed, and certified minister or clergyman. A  
15 missionary's permit may also be issued to persons whose  
16 activities are substantially connected with religious or  
17 missionary work as determined by the President.

18 (8) An entry permit shall be issued to a lawful spouse  
19 of a citizen. The permit shall be revoked or shall be  
20 denied upon a finding that the parties are divorced or  
21 irreconcilably separated, or that the citizen-spouse is  
22 deceased. The President or his designee has the authority  
23 to grant or reissue the permit for indefinite duration upon  
24 a finding of hardship.

25 (9) A dependent's entry permit may be issued to an

1 unmarried child, under the age of eighteen, or a noncitizen  
2 spouse subject to the conditions in subsection (8) of this  
3 section.

4 (10) A spouse or unmarried child under the age of  
5 eighteen of any noncitizen principal listed in this section  
6 except subsection (9) may be issued an entry permit for the  
7 duration of the principal's entry permit and may be renewed  
8 upon renewal of the principal's entry permit."

9 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
10 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming  
11 law without such approval.
