A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 32 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-109 and 4-114, by repealing chapter 5, as established by Public Law No. 4-109, concerning peddlers; to further amend title 50 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-25, 4-68, and 4-109, by further amending section 103, as amended by Public Law No. 4-109, to delete subsection (3) providing for peddlers's permits and renumber subsections (4) through (10); and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA :

1 Section 1. Chapter 5 of title 32 of the Code of the Federated  
2 States of Micronesia, as established by Public Law No. 4-109, is  
3 hereby repealed in its entirety.

4 Section 2. Section 103 of title 50 of the Code of the Federated  
5 States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 4-109, is hereby  
6 further amended to read as follows:

7 "Section 103. Entry permits - Types.

8 (1) A permit is not required for a person visiting  
9 for thirty days or less. For a visit in excess of thirty  
10 days a permit may be issued for an additional period not to  
11 exceed sixty days.

12 (2) A visitor's permit for any lawful purpose,  
13 including performance of necessary services on a short-term  
14 contractual basis, may be issued for a period of specified  
15 duration reflecting the time necessary to accomplish the  
16 purpose.

17 *(3) Notwithstanding any provision of subsections*  
18 *(1) and (2) of this section, a person entering the*  
19 *Federated States of Micronesia for the purpose of engaging*  
20 *in business as a noncitizen peddler, as defined in*  
21 *section 301 of title 32 of the Code of the Federated States*  
22 *of Micronesia, shall be issued a peddler's permit.*

23 (4) An alien worker's permit shall be issued to  
24 a noncitizen entering the Federated States of Micronesia  
25 upon compliance with all National laws relating to private

1 or governmental employment for the period in which the  
2 employment of the alien worker is authorized by contract.  
3 The permit shall be renewed upon extension or renewal of  
4 the alien's lawful employment status.

5 (64) A foreign investor's entry permit shall be  
6 issued for a specified duration and may be renewed upon  
7 renewal or extension of such foreign investor's business  
8 permit.

9 (65) A researcher's entry permit shall be issued for  
10 research in the fields of endeavor that the President deems  
11 in the best interest of and for the well-being of the  
12 citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia; provided  
13 that the President receives from the researcher's intended  
14 place of stay prior permission for his entry. The  
15 President may attach thereto such conditions or  
16 restrictions as he deems necessary.

17 (76) A missionary's permit shall be issued to a duly  
18 ordained, licensed, and certified minister or clergyman. A  
19 missionary's permit may also be issued to persons whose  
20 activities are substantially connected with religious or  
21 missionary work as determined by the President.

22 (87) An entry permit shall be issued to a lawful  
23 spouse of a citizen. The permit shall be revoked or shall  
24 be denied upon a finding that the parties are divorced or  
25 irreconcilably separated, or that the citizen-spouse is

1           deceased. The President or his designee has the authority  
2           to grant or reissue the permit for indefinite duration upon  
3           a finding of hardship.


4           (98) A dependent's entry permit may be issued to an  
5           unmarried child, under the age of eighteen, or a noncitizen  
6           spouse subject to the conditions in subsection (87) of this  
7           section.

8           (109) A spouse or unmarried child under the age of  
9           eighteen of any noncitizen principal listed in this section  
10          except subsection (98) may be issued an entry permit for  
11          the duration of the principal's entry permit and may be  
12          renewed upon renewal of the principal's entry permit."

13          Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
14          President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming  
15          law without such approval.
