A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 5-52, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-55, 5-73 and 5-83, by amending section 13, for the purpose of appropriating the sum of \$743,100 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1989, as supplemental funding for development projects and programs, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 13 of Public Law No. 5-52 is hereby amended  
2 to read as follows:

3 "Section 13. Development budget. The sum of ~~\$2,713,000~~  
4 3,458,100, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is  
5 hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated  
6 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September  
7 30, 1989, for capital improvement and development programs  
8 and projects of the National Government of the Federated  
9 States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1989. The funds  
10 appropriated under this section shall be deemed to come  
11 from the capital account of the Compact of Free  
12 Association. The sum appropriated by this section shall be  
13 apportioned as follows:

14	(1) Business development loan	
15	fund.....	\$1,200,000
16	(2) Livestock development/broiler	
17	production.....	140,000
18	(3) Resource assessment in outer	
19	banks.....	75,000
20	(4) Technical assistance	
21	program.....	250,000
22	(5) U.S. Embassy office.....	<del>1,000,000</del> <u>1,150,000</u>
23	(6) Hemodialysis project.....	50,000
24	<u>(7) Fiji Embassy Office.....</u>	<u>243,100</u>
25	<u>(8) Maritime boundary delineation.....</u>	<u>350,000"</u>
