A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 4-28, Truk State public projects, as amended, by further amending section 2, as amended, for the purpose of changing the use of the funds appropriated thereby, to renumber paragraphs, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-28, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 4-43, 4-64, 4-67, 4-97, 4-112 and 5-10, is hereby  
3 further amended to read as follows:
