1 WHEREAS, the Honorable Antonio Borja Won Pat recently passed
2 away; and

3 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Antonio Borja Won Pat was a
4 member of the Guam delegation which appeared before the United
5 States Congress in 1949 and successfully worked for passage of
6 the Organic Act for Guam; and

7 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Antonio Borja Won Pat served
8 in the Guam Legislature from 1950 to 1965, and served as Speaker
9 of that Legislature; and

10 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Antonio Borja Won Pat became
11 Guam's Washington representative in 1965; and

12 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Antonio Borja Won Pat served as
13 Guam's Delegate in the United States House of Representatives from
14 1973 to 1984; and

15 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Antonio Borja Won Pat served as
16 Chairman of the House Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs
17 Subcommittee on Insular Affairs, in which capacity he worked
18 effectively for the interests of the people of Guam and Micro-
19 nesia; and

20 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Antonio Borja Won Pat will
21 long be remembered as one of the most important leaders in the
22 Western Pacific; now, therefore,

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Fifth Congress of the Federated States
24 of Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1987, that the Congress
25 hereby expresses its deepest sympathy and sincere condolences to

1 the family and friends of the late Honorable Antonio Borja Won Pat
2 and to the people of the Territory of Guam for his untimely
3 passing; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
5 resolution be transmitted to the family of the late Honorable
6 Antonio Borja Won Pat, the Governor of Guam, the Speaker of the
