
A RESOLUTION

Ratifying the "Agreement to Amend the Treaty Among the Governments of the Republic of the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, and the Republic of Palau Regarding the College of Micronesia."

1 WHEREAS, the College of Micronesia was established in 1977
2 pursuant to Public Law No. 7-29, as amended, of the Seventh Congress
3 of Micronesia; and

4 WHEREAS, the College of Micronesia has been accredited by the
5 Western Association of Schools and Colleges and has been endowed as a
6 land grant college under the laws of the United States of America; and

7 WHEREAS, the College of Micronesia is the only post-secondary
8 educational institution in the Republic of the Marshall Islands, the
9 Federated States of Micronesia, and the Republic of Palau and has
10 played a critical role in manpower development, in fostering research
11 and in advancing knowledge and learning about the special challenges
12 and problems of the Micronesian region; and

13 WHEREAS, the "Treaty Among the Governments of the Republic of
14 the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, and the
15 Republic of Palau Regarding the College of Micronesia" was signed and
16 ratified in 1987; and

17 WHEREAS, such Treaty authorizes and provides Government
18 contributions for the College of Micronesia's operations; and

19 WHEREAS, such Treaty will expire on September 30, 1989; and

20 WHEREAS, the duly authorized representatives of the Republic of
21 the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, and the
22 Republic of Palau have signed an agreement to amend such Treaty to
23 provide for the continuation of the College for two additional years;
24 and

25 WHEREAS, such agreement provides for a reduced level of

1 Government contributions in order to shift to College of Micronesia
2 students a portion of the responsibility of paying their educational
3 expenses; and

4 WHEREAS, the College of Micronesia has agreed to work with the
5 Federated States of Micronesia in establishing vocational training
6 programs in any State in the Federated States of Micronesia; now,
7 therefore,

8 BE IT RESOLVED by the Sixth Congress of the Federated States of
9 Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1989, that the Congress hereby
10 ratifies the "Agreement to Amend the Treaty Among the Republic of the
11 Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, and the
12 Republic of Palau Regarding the College of Micronesia"; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution
14 be transmitted to the President and the Secretary of the Department
15 of External Affairs of the Federated States of Micronesia.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 5-89, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-99, 5-126 and 5-129, by further amending section 5, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-99 and 5-126, for the purpose of modifying the uses of funds appropriated for public projects in Truk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 5-89, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-99 and 5-126, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. Mortlocks public projects. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1989, for the purpose of funding certain public projects in the Mortlock Islands, Truk State. The sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

(1) Sub-state projects
