A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 32 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-21, 5-54, 5-109 and 5-134, by amending section 421, for the purpose of authorizing certain notaries public to act in jurisdictions outside the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 421 of title 32 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows: "Section 421. Generally. A notary public has the power 3 4 and is authorized to administer oaths and affirmations, 5 receive proof and acknowledgement of writings, and present 6 and protest commercial paper. A notary public may act officially anywhere in the Trust Territory Federated States 8 of Micronesia, but shall, before so acting in any district 9 State thereof, comply with the provisions of section 414, subchapter I of this chapter. A notary public who serves 10 11 as an officer or employee of the Federated States of 12 Micronesia in any embassy, representative office or liaison 13 office may also act officially anywhere in the jurisdiction in which such embassy, representative office or liaison 14 office is located, PROVIDED that such notary public files a 15 16 literal or photostatic copy of his commission, an 17 impression of his seal and a specimen of his official 18 signature with the Clerk of the Supreme Court of the 19 Federated States of Micronesia in each State thereof and, if required by law, with the clerk of any appropriate court 20 21 in the jurisdiction in which the embassy, representative 22 office or liaison office is located." 23
