A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 5-67, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-111 and 6-6, by further amending sections 2 and 3, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-111 and 6-6, for the purposes of allocating funds appropriated therein, modifying the designation of allottees, extending the lapse date, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 5-67, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 5-111 and 6-5, is hereby further amended to read as

6 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 5-67, as amended by
7 Public Laws Nos. 5-111 and 6-6, is hereby further amended to read as
8 follows:


9 "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
10 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
11 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited
12 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of
13 the funds appropriated under sub-paragraphs (a), (b), (c),
14 (d), (e), (f), and (g) of subsection (1) of section 2 of
15 this act shall be the Governor of the State of Palau. The
16 allottee of the funds appropriated under sub-paragraph (h)
17 of subsection (1) of section 2 of this act, and under sub-
18 paragraphs (d)(1), (e), (f), (g), (h) and (k)(1) of sub-
19 section (2) of section 2 of this act shall be the Palau
20 Community Action Agency. The allottee of the funds appro-
21 priated under sub-paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section
22 2 of this act shall be the Menin Keder Lapalap of the
23 Madolethmw Municipal Government, except for those funds
24 appropriated under sub-paragraph (a)(xxiv) of subsection
25 (2) of section 2 of this act for which the allottee shall

1 be the Menin Keder Lapalap of the Madolenihmw Municipal
2 Government and the Menin Tiensapw of Madolenihmw. The
3 allottee of the funds appropriated under sub-paragraph (b)
4 of subsection (2) of section 2 of this act shall be the
5 Luhken Menlap of the Kittii Municipal Government, except for
6 those funds appropriated under sub-paragraph (b)(iv)(f) of sub-
7 section (2) of section 2 of this act for which the allottee
8 shall be the Luhken Menlap of the Kittii Municipal Government
9 and the Isokohnedi of Kittii. The allottee of the funds
10 appropriated under sub-paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of
11 section 2 of this act shall be the Kolonia Town Mayor. ~~THE~~
12 ~~ALLOTTEE OF THE FUNDS APPROPRIATED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH~~
13 ~~(d)(1) OF SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 2 OF THIS ACT SHALL BE THE~~
14 ~~CHIEF MAGISTRATE OF THE SOKENA MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT.~~ The
15 allottee of the funds appropriated under sub-paragraph (1)
16 of subsection (2) of section 2 of this act shall be the
17 Luhkenkolwof of Sapwuahfik. The allottee of the funds
18 appropriated under sub-paragraph (j) of subsection (2) of
19 section 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of the
20 Nukuoro Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds
21 appropriated under sub-paragraph (k)(1) of subsection (2)
22 of section 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of
23 the Kapingamarangi Municipal Government. The allottee of
24 the funds appropriated under subsection (3) of section 2 of
25 this act shall be the Chairman of the Pohapel Congressional

1 Delegation. Each allottee shall be responsible for ensuring
 2 that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
 3 are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and
 4 that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
 5 appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate
 6 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September
 7 30, ~~1989~~1990."

8 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
 9 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
 10 law without such approval.
