A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend section 9 of Public Law No. 6-24 to increase the stipends for certain delegates to and staff of the Constitutional Convention and to authorize the payment of a stipend to additional delegates to and staff of the Constitutional Convention, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 6-24 is hereby amended to 2 read as follows:
 - "Section 9. Expenses of Delegates and Staff.
 - (1) All delegates and staff of the Convention shall be entitled to per diem and travel expenses at standard rates, as provided by the Financial Management Regulations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, while on the business of the Convention.
 - (2) Any delegate who is an official or employee of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia shall be placed on administrative leave with pay and shall be entitled to receive his regular salary during his service as delegate.
 - (3) Delegates and staff who are not employed by a government and até not cotitied to nécéssaty ttavél éxpénsés and pet diem paradant to subsédition (1) of this sédition, shall be given a \$50/0075.00 per day stipend while on the business of the Convention.
 - (4) Delegates and staff who are employed by a government at a salary of less than \$75.00 per regular work day, including delegates and staff who are not able to take administrative leave with pay, shall be given a stipend of such amount that the sum of their salary and stipend equals \$75.00 while on the business of the Couvention."

Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval. Date: 5-25-90 Introduced by: (by request)
