A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 5-67, as amended by Public Law No. 5-111, by further amending sections 2 and 3, as amended by Public Law No. 5-111, for the purposes of allocating funds appropriated therein and modifying the designation of allottees, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 5-67, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 5-111, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 2. The sum appropriated under section 1 of this
4 act shall be apportioned as follows:

3 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 5-67, as amended by
4 Public Law No. 5-111, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
5 "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
6 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
7 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited
8 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of
9 the funds appropriated under sub-paragraphs (a), (b), (c),
10 (d), (e), (f), and (g) of subsection (1) of section 2 of
11 this act shall be the Governor of the State of Pohnpei.
12 The allottee of the funds appropriated under sub-paragraph
13 (h) of subsection (1) of section 2 of this act, and under
14 sub-paragraphs (d)(ii), (e), (f), (g), (h) and (k)(ii) of
15 subsection (2) of section 2 of this act shall be the
16 Pohnpei Community Action Agency. The allottee of the funds
17 appropriated under sub-paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of
18 section 2 of this act shall be the Menin Keder Lapalap of
19 the Madolenihmw Municipal Government, except for those
20 funds appropriated under sub-paragraph (a)(xxxiv) of
21 subsection (2) of section 2 of this act for which the
22 allottee shall be the ~~Representative of the Municipality of~~
23 ~~Madolenihmw to the Congress of the Federated States of~~
24 ~~Micronesia~~ Menin Keder Lapalap of the Madolenihmw Municipal
25 Government and the Menin Tiensapw of Madolenihmw. The


1 allottee of the funds appropriated under sub-paragraph (b)
2 of subsection (2) of section 2 of this act shall be the
3 Luhken Menlap of the Kitti Municipal Government, except for
4 those funds appropriated under sub-paragraph (b)(iv)(f) of
5 subsection (2) of section 2 of this act for which the
6 allottee shall be the *Representative of the Municipality of*
7 *Kitti to the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia*
8 Luhken Menlap of the Kitti Municipal Government and the
9 Isokohnedi of Kitti. The allottee of the funds appropriated
10 under sub-paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section 2 of
11 this act shall be the Kolonia Town Mayor. The allottee of
12 the funds appropriated under sub-paragraph (d)(i) of
13 subsection (2) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chief
14 Magistrate of the Sokehs Municipal Government. The allottee
15 of the funds appropriated under sub-paragraph (i) of sub-
16 section (2) of section 2 of this act shall be the Luhkenkolwof
17 of Sapwuahfik. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
18 sub-paragraph (j) of subsection (2) of section 2 of this act
19 shall be the Chief Magistrate of the Nukuoro Municipal
20 Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
21 sub-paragraph (k)(i) of subsection (2) of section 2 of this
22 act shall be the Chief Magistrate of the Kapingamarangi
23 Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated
24 under subsection (3) of section 2 of this act shall be the
25 Chairman of the Pohnpei Congressional Delegation. Each

1 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 2 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
 3 solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no
 4 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated.
 5 The authority of the allottees to obligate funds appro-
 6 priated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1989."

7 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
 8 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
 9 becoming law without such approval.
