A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 5-52, as amended, by further amending sections 12, 13, and 16, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-73, 5-90, 5-110, 5-127, and 6-4, for the purpose of correcting the allocation of certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 12 of Public Law No. 5-52, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 5-73, 5-110, 5-127 and 6-4, is hereby further amended
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 12. Other National Government programs, grants,
5 subsidies, contributions, and refunds. The sum of
6 ~~\$2,792,355~~ 3,166,355, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
7 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated
8 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
9 1989, for special programs, grants, subsidies, contributions,
10 and refunds of the National Government of the Federated
11 States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1989. The sum
12 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

(1) Special programs:

- 14 (a) Congressional election..... \$ 175,000

11 Section 2. Section 13 of Public Law No. 5-52, as amended by
12 Public Laws Nos. 5-90, 5-127 and 6-4, is hereby further amended to
13 read as follows:

14 "Section 13. Development budget. The sum of \$3,779,972
15 3,405,972, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
16 hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated
17 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September
18 30, 1989, for capital improvement and development programs
19 and projects of the National Government of the Federated
20 States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1989. The funds
21 appropriated under this section shall be deemed to come from
22 the capital account of the Compact of Free Association. The sum
23 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:


16 Section 3. Section 16 of Public Law No. 5-52, as amended by Public
 17 Law No. 6-4, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

18 "Section 16. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 19 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
 20 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
 21 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
 22 Management Act of 1979, as amended; PROVIDED, however, that
 23 the allottees for funds appropriated under subparagraph (p)
 24 of subsection (2) of section 12 shall be the executive
 25 directors of the four State Community Action Agencies, and

1 that those funds shall not be transferred from the General
2 Fund to any Community Action Agency until the executive
3 directors have submitted to the Secretary of Finance a copy
4 of their written agreement regarding the distribution of
5 funds among the four agencies. Each allottee shall be
6 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes
8 specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred
9 in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the
10 allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall
11 lapse as of September 30, 1989; PROVIDED, however, that the
12 authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated
13 by subsection (8) of section 2, by subparagraphs (f) and (g)
14 of subsection (1) of section 12, and by subparagraphs (t) and
15 (u) of subsection (2) of section 12 shall lapse as of
16 September 30, 1990, and, PROVIDED FURTHER, that the
17 authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by
18 sections 6, 9, 10 and 13 shall not lapse."

19 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
20 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
21 law without such approval.
