A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 2 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-2, 5-21 and 5-50, by further amending section 203, as amended by Public Law No. 5-21, for the purpose of merging the Division of Labor, a subdivision of the Department of Resources and Development, with the Division of Immigration, a subdivision of the Office of the Attorney General, for the purpose of establishing a Division of Labor and Immigration to be under the authority of the Department of Resources and Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 203 of title 2 of the Code of the Federated
2 States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 5-21, is hereby
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 203. Departments.

5 (1) There shall be the following departments which
6 shall be responsible for major programs or administrative
7 support areas in the Government of the Federated States:

- 8 (a) Department of Finance;
9 (b) Department of External Affairs;
10 (c) Department of Transportation;
11 (d) Department of Resources and Development; and
12 (e) Department of Human Resources.

13 (2) The Division of Labor shall be removed as a
14 subdivision of the Office of the Attorney General and
15 merged with the Division of Labor to establish the Division
16 of Labor and Immigration. The Division of Labor and
17 Immigration shall be under the authority of the Department
18 of Resources and Development.

19 (3) The administrative head of each department shall
20 be designated as a 'Secretary.'

21 (4) Succession.

22 (a) Any reference to the Office of Information,
23 the Office of Personnel, the Office of Education, or the
24 Office of Health Services shall apply to the appropriate
25 successor entity.



1 (b) Any reference to any official or employee of
2 an entity referred to in subsection (14)(a) of this section
3 shall be construed as applying to the person holding the
4 same or most similar position in the appropriate successor
5 entity."

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect 30 days after becoming
7 law.

8 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
9 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
10 law without such approval.
