A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 5-67, Pohnpei State public projects, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-111, 6-6 and 6-15, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-111, 6-6 and 6-15, for the purpose of modifying the use of funds appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 5-67, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 5-111, 6-6 and 6-15, is hereby further amended to


