
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 2 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-2, 5-21, 5-50 and 6-62, by further amending section 204, as amended by Public Law No. 5-21, to provide for an Office of Congressional Relations, to appropriate the sum of \$30,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1991, to fund said office, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 204 of title 2 of the Code of the Federated
2 States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 5-21, is hereby
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 204. Other executive offices. There shall be the
5 following executive offices:

- 6 (1) Office of the Attorney General;
- 7 (2) Office of Budget;
- 8 (3) Office of Administrative Services;
- 9 (4) Office of Planning and Statistics; ~~and~~
- 10 (5) Office of the Public Defender/; and
- 11 (6) Office of Congressional Relations."

12 Section 2. The sum of \$30,000, or so much thereof as may be
13 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
14 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September
15 30, 1991, for the purpose of providing initial funding for the Office
16 of Congressional Relations.

17 Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
18 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable
19 law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
20 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
21 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
22 the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are
23 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the
24 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of
25 September 30, 1991.

1 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
3 law without such approval.
