Public Law No. 7 - 126

## AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 7-96 by amending sections 1 and 5, and by adding a new section 5, for the purpose of modifying the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein, by renumbering section 6, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 7-96 is hereby amended to
2	read as follows:
3	"Section 1. Elementary and secondary education needs in
4	Chuuk. The sum of \$900,000, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
6	of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
7	year ending September 30, 1993, for the purpose of funding
8	elementary and secondary education needs in Chuuk State.
9	The sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as
10	follows:
11	(1) Saramen Chuuk Academy \$ 75,000
12	(2) Berea Christian School 75,000
13	(3) Northern Namoneas
14	(a) Mizpah High School 25,000
15	(b) Moen Junior High School 20,000
16	(c) St. Cecilia School 10,000
17	(d) Iras Elementary 10,000
18	(e) Mechitiw Elementary 10,000
19	(f) Muan Elementary 10,000

1	Section 2. Public Law No. 7-96 is hereby amended by adding a new
2	section 5 to read as follows:
3	"Section 5. The sum of \$15,000, or so much thereof as may
4	be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
5	of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
6	ending September 30, 1993, for the purpose of promoting the
7	1993 Kuttu Dedication Day celebration."
8	Section 3. Section 5 of Public Law No. 7-96 is hereby amended
9	to read as follows:
10	"Section 6. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
11	allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
12	accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited
13	to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of
14	the funds appropriated under subsections (1) and (2) of
15	section 1 of this act shall be the respective school board
16	of each institution; the allottee of the funds appropriated
17	under subsection (4) of section 1 of this act shall be the
18	Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of
19	the funds appropriated under subsection (5) of section 1 of
20	this act shall be the President of the Federated States of
21	Micronesia or the President's designee; and the allottee of
22	the remaining subsections of section 1 shall be the
23	Governor of Chuuk State. The President or the President's
24	designee shall be the allottee of the funds appropriated
25	under sections 2 and 4 of this act. The allottee of the

1	funds appropriated under subsections (1) and (3) of section
2	3 of this act shall be the Governor of Pohnpei State or his
3	designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
4	subsections (2) and (4) of section 3 of this act shall be
5	the Pohnpei Community Action Agency. The allottee of the
6	funds appropriated under section 5 of this act shall be the
7	Lower Mortlocks Development Authority. The allottees shall
8	be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much
9	thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the
10	purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations
11	are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The
12	authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated
13	by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1994."
14	Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 7-96 is hereby renumbered
15	as section 7.
16	Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
17	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
18	law without such approval.
