CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 7-152

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 6-49, as amended, by further amending sections 6 and 10, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 6-55, 6-96, 6-112, 7-3 and 7-18, to modify the use of certain funds appropriated therein for public projects in the Pattiw, Weito, and Hall Islands of Chuuk State and to change the allottee of certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Section 6 of Public Law No. 6-49, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 6-55, 6-112, 7-3 and 7-18, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 3 "Section 6. Pattiw, Weito, and Hall Islands public projects. 4 The sum of \$240,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, 5 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated 6 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1990, for the purpose of funding certain public projects in the Pattiw, Weito, and Hall Islands, Chuuk State. The sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows: 10 (1) Puluwat public projects..... \$ 20,000 11 (2) Onoun medicine, food and clothing, 12 and freight costs of typhoon relief goods..... 13 (3) Nomwin medicine, food and clothing, 14 and freight costs of typhoon relief goods..... 20,000 15 (4) Lien Pisarach operation and maintenance... 13,124 16 (5) Ruo medicine, food and clothing, 17 19,000 and freight costs of typhoon relief goods..... 18 (6) Makur medicine, food and clothing, 19 7,000 and freight costs of typhoon relief goods..... 20

19	"Section 10. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
20	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
21	managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
22	applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
23	Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds appro-
24	priated by sections 4, 6(2), 6(3), 6(5), 6(6), 6(7),
25	6(8), 6(9), 6(10), 6(11), 6(12) and 6(13) of this act shall

be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia. The
allottee of the funds appropriated by subsection (2) of
section 1 of this act shall be the Truk Organization of
Community Action (TOCA); the allottee of the funds appro-
priated by subsection (4) of section 1 shall be the Lower
Mortlocks Development Authority; and the allottee of the
funds appropriated by subsections (1) , (3) , (5) , (6) , (7) ,
(8), (9), (10), and (11) of section 1 and by section 2 shall
be the Governor of Chuuk State. The allottee of the funds
appropriated under subsection (12) of section 1 of this act
shall be the Peace Corps Representative, Chuuk State. The
allottees of the funds appropriated by sections 3, 5, $6(1)$,
6(4), 6(14), 6(15), 6(16), 6(17), 7, 8 and 9 of this act
shall be the local development authorities of the areas for
which the projects are designated. The allottees shall be
responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much
thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the
purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are
incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority
of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act
shall not lapse until expended."
