## AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 6-91, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 6-103 and 7-1, by further amending sections 1, 5 and 7, as amended by Public Law No. 6-103, and by further amending section 12, as amended by Public Law No. 7-1, for the purpose of appropriating the sum of \$660,301 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1991, as supplemental funding for operating expenses of the executive branch, agencies of the National Government, other National Government grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds, and the marine surveillance program, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
