## A RESOLUTION

To ratify and accede to the Articles of Agreement establishing the United Nations Convention on Biological Diversity.

- 1 WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia membership in
- 2 the Convention on Biological Diversity is important to
- 3 contribute to conservation and sustainable use of biological
- 4 diversity which will benefit the Country and also strengthen its
- 5 friendly relationship among other states; and
- 6 WHEREAS, conservation of biological diversity is a common
- 7 concern of humankind; and
- 8 WHEREAS, it is important and there is a need to promote
- 9 international or global cooperation among states for the
- 10 conservation of biological diversity and the sustainable use of
- 11 its components; and
- 12 WHEREAS, a meeting of many nations was held in Rio De
- 13 Janeiro in June of 1992 to discuss global environmental issues;
- 14 and
- 15 WHEREAS, the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
- 16 signed the Articles of Agreement establishing the Convention on
- 17 June 12, 1992;
- 18 WHEREAS, every nation but one attending that meeting signed
- 19 the Articles of Agreement establising the Convention on
- 20 Biological Diversity; and
- 21 WHEREAS, each Party to the Convention shall develop national
- 22 strategies, plans or programs for the conservation and
- 23 sustainable use of biological diversity; and
- 24 WHEREAS, the fundamental requirement for the conservation of
- 25 biological diversity is the conservation of ecosystems and

- 1 natural habitats and the maintenance and recovery of viable
- 2 populations of species in their natural surroundings; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the conservation of components of biological
- 4 diversity outside their natural habitats, hereinafter referred
- 5 to as ex-situ conservation, is also important for conservation
- 6 of biological diversity; and
- 7 WHEREAS, each Party shall, as far as possible and
- 8 appropriate, cooperate in providing financial and other support
- 9 for biological diversity conservation, particularly to
- 10 developing countries; and
- 11 WHEREAS, each Party shall, as far as possible and
- 12 appropriate, cooperate in providing financial and other support
- 13 for ex-situ conservation of biological diversity and in the
- 14 establishment and maintenance of conservation facilities in
- 15 developing countries; and
- 16 WHEREAS, developed country Parties may provide, and
- 17 developing country Parties may avail themselves of, financial
- 18 resources related to the implementation of this Convention
- 19 through bilateral, regional and other multilateral channels; and
- 20 WHEREAS, there shall be a mechanism for the provision of
- 21 financial resources to developing country Parties for purposes
- 22 of this Convention on a grant or concessional basis; and
- 23 WHEREAS, the provisions of this Convention shall not affect
- 24 the rights and obligations of any Party deriving from any
- 25 international agreement, unless the exercise of those rights and

1	obligations would cause a serious damage or threat to biological
2	diversity; now, therefore,
3	BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventh Congress of the Federated
4	States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 1992, that
5	pursuant to section 2(b) of article IX of the Constitution of
6	the Federated States of Micronesia the Congress hereby ratifies
7	and accedes to the Articles of Agreement of the Convention on
8	Biological Diversity; and
9	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon receipt of this resolution
10	the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or the
11	Secretary of External Affairs shall lodge with the Secretary-
12	General of the United Nations, as depositary, an instrument of
13	accession; and
14	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
15	resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated
16	States of Micronesia.
