A RESOLUTION

Respectfully requesting the President and the Attorney General to send officers during the upcoming Congressional elections to oversee the voting and vote counting in Manaio, Chukuram, Neton and other suspect polling sites in Faichuk, Chuuk State.

- 1 WHEREAS, in the March, 1991 Congressional elections there were
- 2 election irregularities in the Manaio, Chukuram, Neton and perhaps
- 3 other polling places in Faichuk; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the irregularities caused severe disruptions in the
- 5 election process; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the votes of a large number of individuals in these
- 7 polling districts may have been affected by the irregularities;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, some citizens in these polling areas are concerned
- 10 that irregularities will occur again unless the vote is closely
- 11 monitored by objective officers; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the National Government has an interest in assuring
- 13 that all citizens have a timely, fair opportunity to vote and an
- 14 open, accurate vote count; now, therefore,
- 15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventh Congress of the Federated
- 16 States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 1992, that the Congress
- 17 hereby respectfully requests the President and the Attorney General
- 18 of the Federated States of Micronesia to send officers during the
- 19 upcoming Congressional elections to Manaio, Chukuram, Neton and other
- 20 polling places of suspected election irregularities; and
- 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution
- 22 be transmitted to the President and the Attorney General of the
- 23 Federated States of Micronesia.
