A RESOLUTION

Ratifying the "Agreement to Extend the Treaty Among the Governments of the Republic of the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, and the Republic of Palau Regarding the College of Micronesia."

1 WHEREAS, the "Treaty Among the Governments of the Republic of
2 the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, and the
3 Republic of Palau Regarding the College of Micronesia" was signed
4 and ratified in 1987 and amended in 1989; and

5 WHEREAS, meetings were held August 30-31, 1991 regarding the
6 future status of such Treaty; and

7 WHEREAS, an agreement was reached at those meetings that a
8 one year interim extension of the Treaty was needed to allow the
9 parties to restructure the College of Micronesia; and

10 WHEREAS, the duly authorized representatives of the Republic
11 of the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, and
12 the Republic of Palau have signed an agreement to extend such
13 Treaty to provide for the continuation of the College for one
14 additional year to September 30, 1992 or such earlier termination
15 date as mutually agreed by the signatory governments; and


16 WHEREAS, such agreement provides that the College be
17 restructured to become a regional consortium of independent
18 institutions with directional and oversight responsibility being
19 transferred to a locally based board for each of the campus
20 components; now, therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventh Congress of the Federated
22 States of Micronesia, Second Regular Session, 1991, that the
23 Congress hereby ratifies the "Agreement to Extend the Treaty
24 Among the Governments of the Republic of the Marshall Islands,
25 the Federated States of Micronesia, and the Republic of Palau

1 Regarding the College of Micronesia"; and

2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
3 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated
4 States of Micronesia and the Secretary of the Department of
5 External Affairs of the Federated States of Micronesia.
